### **Matters Arising:**

## **Correspondence:**

Clevedon bandstand has available dates for this summer, the secretary to investigate potential booking.

Youth band have been made Sherborne bowls clubs charity of the year, they would like the band to play on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2016 for a cheque presentation, though this may clash with another booking, the secretary will liaise with Jim as to booking this.

Bradford Abbas social club have asked if the beer band are available in October, some potential dates have been forwarded to them but no response as yet.

#### Agenda:

Fee increase: It was proposed and agreed that the band would increase the booking fee from £300 to £350, this will take effect from 2017 as our current 2016 bookings already have fees agreed. It would be noted to our regular bookings that our fee will be going up for 2017.

Child protection: The committee has been given a proposed child protection policy from a parent from the Youth band who is happy to be our representative. The policy has been sent to committee members for review.

Contest update: Coach is booked and most players are now registered with only a couple outstanding which the contest secretary has in hand, a rehearsal room needs to be booked.

Band dinner: It has been proposed to have the band dinner at the pub in Thornford, the band's president is looking into this.

#### Other Business:

A committee member has been lead to believe that the band has been booked for Henstridge church on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016, no other committee members know anything about this booking and we thought it may be a mistake, if the event is advertised as the town band then we would contact them.

The Chairman to arrange a conductor for the contest rehearsal on 19<sup>th</sup> February as our musical director is away that day.

Richard Frost to book the Digby hall for 24<sup>th</sup> September for the Proms concert and 17<sup>th</sup> December for the Christmas concert.
