Paul was, for many years, a member of the BBC Symphony Orchestra and a Professor at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama for 30 years. Paul has been involved in the Brass Band Movement all his life, from learning the cornet in his local band here in Sherborne to conducting some of Britain's finest. He has also adjudicated at the highest level, including The Nationals at the RAH, The British Open and Brass in Concert. His conducting career saw him win Championship section area contests in Wales and London. Bands he has conducted include the triple winning Desford Colliery Band, Sun Life, Flowers, the mighty Sherborne Town, Parc and Dare, (Welsh Champions), and Hanwell (London Champions).
